NDC invites EOI from reputed / experienced craft experts for empanelment to undertake work for vetting and content enrichment of various types of craft objects of National Crafts Museum & Hastkala Academy.

A: INTRODUCTION

National Design Centre (NDC) in association with Indira Gandhi National Centre for the Arts (IGNCA) is undertaking the project for documentation of the various crafts with an objective to preserve the rich heritage of artifacts of National Crafts Museum & Hastkala Academy (NCM&HA) for future generations. It is estimated that 30,000 artifacts of various craft categories are available with NCM&HA. The project shall be completed within a year time.

These craft objects preserved by the Museum over a period of 60 years which were collected from various states of India such as Andhra Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Delhi, Gujarat, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu and Kashmir, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Orissa, Punjab, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu, Tripura, Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal. The collection reflects the continuing traditions of handicrafts and handlooms.

Museum collection consists of a variety of traditional artifacts such as Textiles, a vast range of metal lamps, sculptures, utensils etc, Wood-works, Folk/tribal paintings, range of cane and bamboo crafts, clay and terracotta figures and a lot more. The exquisite examples of textiles include Kalamkaris, Jamawars, Pashmina and Shahtosh shawls, embroidered fabrics especially Kanthas, Chikankari works

and chaklas Tie and Die (Bandhani) fabrics, Baluchar and Jamdaani saris, Pichwais, phulkaris, Ikat fabrics of Orissa, Chamba Rumals, Block printed textile fabrics of Gujarat and Rajasthan, Himru textile pieces of Maharashtra, Naga shawls, Chanderi saris and a variety of tribal textiles of the Lambadi, Toda and Naga tribes of North- eastern India.

In view of the sanctity of this project, NDC would like to engage experienced craft experts of various craft categories having background in similar field for undertake the job in a professional and time bound manner for vetting and editing of the content which shall be provided by IGNCA.

B) AIMS OF THE PROJECT

The objective is to provide single window information about the art object to the visitors, researchers, students and art lovers. The basic objectives are as follows:

- > To preserve objects, craft techniques and methods through restoration, documentation.
- To democratize & make crafts accessible to everyone through archiving and display.
- To connect & make the crafts museum an epicenter for collaboration and interdisciplinary experiments by connecting existing stakeholders attracting the interest of larger community towards crafts and heritage of India.

C: INDICATIVE SCOPE OF WORK

- Vetting of contents prepared by IGNCA for approximately 30,000 art objects
- Enrichment of contents as per need and requirement.
- The work / content to be provided to each expert on regular basis.
- The text material to be returned by the expert within a stipulated time period.
